

Queensland Health Partner Cash Funding

2023 Guidelines and Conditions of Award

Description and Purpose of Funding

Through its partnership with Queensland Health (QH), QAEHS has funding available for University of Queensland-led environmental health science research projects.

QAEHS is able to distribute funds as Queensland Health 'Partner Cash' contributions' to ARC, NHMRC and other National Competitive Grants (Category 1), Queensland Government and other government grants (Category 2), and any other grants that require such contributions (e.g., NHMRC Partnership Grants, ARC Linkage Projects).

Funding

The Queensland Health Partner Cash contribution will be capped at \$50,000 per annum for up to 5 years. It is expected that the QH contribution will account for no more than 30% of total project funding.

Applications that include a confirmed cash commitment from other industry partners will be viewed favourably.

Funding awarded for successful projects may be reduced if successful requests exceed the total available funding.

Eligibility

Proposed projects must:

- Be relevant to the field of environmental health sciences
- Be led by a University of Queensland researcher
- Involve a QAEHS theme leader in the research team

Selection criteria for assessment of applications

Requests for QH partner cash contributions will be assessed using the following criteria:

- strategic value to QAEHS;
- strategic value to Queensland Health;
- excellence of proposed project/usefulness of equipment;
- research excellence of team; and
- value for money (including confirmed cash commitment from other partners).



Application Process

Applications should be submitted using the Queensland Health Partner Cash Funding Application Form to <u>gaehs.research@uq.edu.au</u> by no later than 8 September 2023.

Conditions of Award

- Recipients of a QH cash contribution must submit their full application to the grantor by 30 June 2024.
- The contribution from QH must account for no more than 30% of the total project funding.
